Recently, we have purchased a second defibrillator which is installed over the mailboxes in the main entrance-way of the Sanctuary. One defibrillator is installed over the water fountain in the area nearest Wesley Hall for use of persons who may be attending a function there. The Memorial Fund has funded money to add a second unit nearer the sanctuary to ensure the optimum protection of worshippers who may have a problem or condition which becomes pronounced during a need while worshipping.

A training program for persons, (male or female) who can operate the defibrillators will be held on Tuesday, April 7, 2020 in the Church library beginning promptly at 7 P.M. The United Methodist Women have a Meeting beginning at 7:30 P. M. so the training will only be ½ hour. Please consider attending this vital service to our congregation so that everyone is protected when a need arises. In addition, ushers are encouraged to attend also so that a plan will be put in place to address emergencies prior to an incident. Pastor Blaik, Joe Swerk and Ethel Hibbs will appreciate your support as they have endeavored to protect worshippers in our Sanctuary in the future.
