- **Wires of any kind are great**-extension cords, all computer cables, cable, phone wire, speaker wire.
- **Electronics**-Computers and laptops, flat screen monitors, printers, stereos, tape players, VCR or CD players, **(but no old fashioned FAT monitors or TV's)**, battery back-up units, light fixtures. **Ask your employer, too!**
- **Appliances**-ovens, washers, dryers, dehumidifiers, microwaves, toaster ovens, metal sinks and tubs.
- **Steel and aluminum** cans, if clean. Please crush aluminum cans to save space.
- **Small Appliances**- all phones, cell phones, vacuums, lamps, toasters, mixers, battery back-up, hair dryers, curlers, heaters, faucets.
- **BASEMENT and GARAGE**- Mowers, chain saws, power tools, hand-tools, jars and boxes of screws, nails, hardware, shovels, rakes, **auto or tractor** batteries, fluorescent lamps and ballast, radiators, bikes.
- Buckets, empty paint cans, empty spray cans, chains, cable.
- **Backyard**-cast iron birdbath, lawn chairs, pipes, grills, fencing.
- **Cars**- we will arrange to take a car, any condition.

Try putting a box in your garage to gather metal items you might otherwise be throwing away, you may be surprised at how much you find! Please drop off at parking lot near the white shed at the Newtown United Methodist Church, 35 Liberty Street.
